Islay character, distinctive spiciness and surprising drinkability. It is a lively whisky, peaty and

full in flavour, without being as intense as its more famous counterparts.

Its availability is limited, and with a name that is difficult to pronounce, Caol Ila has remained an almost secret Islay malt. The name - pronounced 'cull-eela' is gaelic for 'Sound of Islay'. The distillery is appropriately hidden in a cove near Port Askaig, overlooking the Sound of Islay, across which the ferry chugs to the nearby island of Jura.

Colour: Pale yellow.

Nose: Rum notes to the fore with burnt toffee, vanilla and hints

of new rubber. Followed by the Caol IIa character -

kippers and cigar ash.

Palate: Sweet, phenolic with birchwood and tar-like flavours. A

surge of salty, briny flavours.

With Water

Nose: The rum character remains with sweet, oily notes. Hints

of TCP

Palate: Phenolic - medicinal with salty - driftwood flavours.

Slightly ashy.

Body: Soft for an Islay whisky.

Finish: Ashy.

Cask Type: Refill Sherry Casks followed by 6 years in a Vintage Rum

Butt.

Whisky Style: Rum elements on the nose with the Caol Ila dominating

the palate.
